10. Automated decision-making

No automated decisions are made as according to the EU GDPR article 22.

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11. Your privacy rights

You as a data subject have rights in respect of personal data we hold on you. In case you want to exercise your rights, a signed request should be sent to the person responsible for the Register.

The data subject has the right to:

- a) request the correction of incorrect or incomplete data,
- b) request the erasure or moving of the data, and
- c) limit the processing of personal data

as according to the EU GDPR articles 18 & 21.

The data subject also has the right to withdraw one's consent to the data processing or make a complaint of the concerning matters to the appropriate authorities.

In addition to the above, the date subject can object to processing of personal data for direct marketing.
